1 Basis of Preparation

The interim financial report is unaudited and has been prepared in accordance with MFRS 134: Interim Financial Reporting issued by the Malaysian Accounting Standards Board ("MASB") and paragraph 9.22 of the Listing Requirements of Bursa Malaysia Securities Berhad ("Bursa Malaysia"). The figures for the cumulative period in the current quarter to 30 June 2015 have not been audited.

The interim financial statements should be read in conjunction with the audited financial statements of the Company and its subsidiaries ("Group") for the year ended 31 December 2014.

The Group has adopted the Malaysian Financial Reporting Standard (MFRS) framework issued by MASB with effect from 1 January 2012. 13 Review of Performance

The Group recorded lower revenue at RM24.1 million in the current quarter as compared to RM26.7 million registered in the corresponding quarter last year. The lower revenue recorded was mainly due to the decrease in sales from the automated manufacturing solution operating segment which was slightly offset by the higher revenue contribution from the automated equipment operating segment. Despite the lower revenue recorded, the Group achieved higher profit before tax of RM4.0 million in the current quarter as compared to RM2.5 million in the previous corresponding quarter mainly due to the better product mix with higher margin achieved in this reporting quarter.

Performance of the respective operating segments for the current quarter as compared to the previous corresponding quarter is analysed as follows:-

1) Automated equipment

This segment recorded a slight increase in revenue by RM0.9 million (4.4%) to RM20.3 million as compared to the previous corresponding quarter mainly due to higher demand for automated equipment from semiconductor market. Consequently, this segment recorded a higher profit before tax of RM5.2 million against RM3.3 million in the previous corresponding quarter mainly attributable to the better product mix with higher margin achieved.

2) Automated manufacturing solution

Revenue from this segment was RM3.5 million lower than the previous corresponding quarter mainly due to lower demand for the integrated manufacturing solution from customers in the current quarter. As a result, this segment recorded a higher loss before tax of RM0.9 million in the current quarter as compared to RM0.5 million in the previous corresponding quarter.

Notes To The Interim Financial Report For Quarter Ended 30 June 2015

Material Changes in the Quarterly Results as Compared with the Preceding Quarter

For the second quarter ended 30 June 2015, the Group recorded higher revenue at RM24.1 million as compared to the revenue of RM19.4 million in the preceding quarter. The higher revenue recorded was due to the increase in sales from the automated equipment operating segment which was partially offset by the drop in revenue contribution from the automated manufacturing solution operating segment. Consequently, the Group achieved a higher profit before tax of RM4.0 million as compared to RM1.4 million in the preceding quarter.

Performance of the respective operating segments for the second quarter ended 30 June 2015 as compared to the preceding quarter is analysed as follows:-

1) Automated equipment

The increase in revenue by RM12.7 million in the current quarter to RM20.3 million as compared to the preceding quarter was mainly due to higher demand for automated equipment from semiconductor market coupled with the delivery of projects which were deferred in the preceding quarter. Consequently, this segment turned around by achieving a profit before tax of RM5.2 million against the loss before tax of RM0.7 million in the preceding quarter.

2) Automated manufacturing solution

Revenue from this segment was RM8.0 million lower than the preceding quarter mainly due to lower demand for the integrated manufacturing solution from customers in the current quarter. Due to the drop in revenue, this segment recorded a loss before tax of RM0.9 million in the current quarter as compared to the profit before tax of RM2.4 million in the preceding quarter.

15 Current Year Prospect

The Group generally possess an optimistic view of the market in the second half of the year especially with the emergence of Internet of Things which has arisen on the back of the growing interconnectedness of things. Smart electronic devices are the key driving force behind the semiconductor growth in 2015 and therefore, more sophisticated test solution is required for the manufacturing of these smart devices. Within this context, new product introduction will continue to be an important agenda to enhance customers' accessibility to more innovative and quality product offerings.

Subject to the external market conditions and macroeconomic factors, the Company believes that its performance will continue to grow positively with these prospects in the horizon.
